Gateway Requirements	UC/CSU “a-g” Requirements
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Humanities (English/History/Civics): 80 credits (4 years) • Mathematics: 30 credits (3 years, at least through Algebra 2) • Sciences: 30 credits (3 years) • Spanish: 30 credits* (3 years, at least through Spanish III or *Heritage Spanish 2 and passing grade on AP) • Arts: 20 credits (4 semesters; 9th grade takes Fundamentals of Art; 10th grade takes visual art or drama) • Others: 40 credits, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> --9th Grade Seminar, College Counseling --Project Week -- Other electives • Physical education: 20 credits 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • “a” History: 2 years • “b” English: 4 years • “c” Math: 3 years required, 4 recommended • “d” Science: 2 years required, 3 recommended • “e” Language other than English: 2 years required, 3 recommended • “f” Arts: 1 year required • “g” College Preparatory Electives: 1 year <p>* Classes in your freshman year count toward the “scholarship requirement” for college; in other words, freshmen courses are included in GPA and admissions’ requirements.</p> <p>* Ds do not count as a passing grade for UC or CSU admission and must be retaken. (For rare exceptions to this rule, see Mr. Rangel or Ms. Schafer.)</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please note that Gateway requires students to take a minimum of six classes each semester, except in senior year when students must take a minimum of 5 classes. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Community Service Requirement: Gateway students are required to spend at least 25 hours serving the community each year. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • P.E.: 60 hours of exercise = 5 credits (Official p.e. logs must be turned in to Mr. Killmaier)
